

Breastfeeding in Derbyshire at birth, 10 days, and 6-8 weeks (Q1 - Q4 2023/24)











Breastfeeding prevalence comparing the most deprived decile to the least deprived decile using the latest IMD data.

Baby's first feed breastmilk

Most recent data in 2023/24 showed that 68% of babies in Derbyshire received breastmilk as their first feed, significantly lower when compared to England (72%).

Birth Derbyshire Dales and High Peak had significantly higher

breastfeeding (74% and 73%) than Derbyshire (68%). **Bolsover** had significantly lower (62%) than Derbyshire.


BF prevalence at 6-8 weeks

Derbyshire continues to have a significantly lower breastfeeding prevalence at 6-8 weeks compared to England.




